

According to the Undergraduate Catalog, nine semester hours of designated University of Texas at Austin coursework in air force science (AFS), military science (M S), or naval science (N S) may be counted toward any degree in the College of Liberal Arts, except for students enrolled in the Military Leadership minor*. Cross-listed courses may be used as appropriate to fulfill other degree requirements. The following is a list of the designated ROTC courses eligible for academic credit.

*Students pursuing the Military Leadership minor are required to complete fifteen semester credit hours chosen from the below list and must include six upper-division hours in a single field of study. Only students in the 2020-2022, 2022-2024, and 2024-2026 catalogs are eligible to pursue the Military Leadership minor.
