In addition to the required courses AFR 303, AFR 375, and AFR 376, AFR majors on the 16-18 catalog are required to take three courses in ONE track (either "Critical Race, Gender, and Sexuality Theories", "Performance, Music, Art, and Literature", "Language, History, and Behavioral and Social Sciences", or "Law, Education, Health, and Policy"), and two more AFR courses out of any category as additional AFR. 15 hours of all AFR coursework must be upper-division.

AFR majors on 16-18 must also have a 15 hour minor or 18 certificate in another field of study.

Though some courses can count for multiple requirements, a course can only be applied to requirements ONCE.
