

China Studies Scholarship for Study Abroad

Apply in Fall (deadline November 1) for study abroad the following Spring semester

Apply in Spring (deadline March 15) for study abroad the following Summer or Fall semester

The Department of Asian Studies offers the China Studies Study Abroad Scholarship, which provides partial financial support for students planning to study in the People's Republic of China or Taiwan during the summer session or anytime during the academic year. The scholarship amount varies each year, depending on the budget and number of scholarships awarded. The amount is not intended to cover the full cost of a program, so students should pursue additional sources of funding.

Eligibility: Students must have completed at least one year of Chinese at UT Austin by the end of the semester in which they apply. The competition is based on academic achievement, financial need, and merit of the proposed study abroad program. Undergraduate students must enroll in a language or other organized program. Graduate students conducting research may propose other projects abroad if their faculty advisor agrees to supervise their work.
