

Kevyn Kennedy and Chien-Yi Kung Endowed Excellence Fund in Chinese Studies

Deadline: March 1

The scholarship awards (amounts of \$250-\$1000) support undergraduates who study Chinese language or courses related to China or Taiwan at UT. Preference will be given to students who present a defined plan for the scholarship award, such as support for a research project (e.g. thesis) or study abroad in a Chinese-speaking country. Preference is also given to students who are working their way through college. Financial need is also considered.

Eligibility:

For full-time undergraduate students currently enrolled in Chinese language courses and/or content courses related to China or Taiwan.

- Completion of a minimum of 15 hours in-residence coursework at time of application.
- **UT-Austin GPA of 3.25**
- Evidence of commitment to study of Chinese language, or the study of China and/or Taiwan
- Evidence of financial need
