BEOP allows qualified economics majors to take a set of **major-level accounting and finance courses** in McCombs School of Business.

Declared Economics majors can receive a **transcript-recognized minor** in Accounting, Finance, or Wealth Management.

There is **no deadline to apply**; however space may be limited.

Students should plan for a **minimum of four semesters** after admission to complete the program, due to course sequencing.

Admission Requirements

- **Declared Economics** major
- **UT GPA:** 3.0 or higher
- **ECO GPA:** 3.0 or higher
- **ECO 329 completed** with a C or higher
