HOW LONG ARE THE EXAMS?

The exams length varies based on the level taken:
A1: 2h15' - A2: 2h45' - B1/B2: 3h45' - C1: 4h50' - C2: 5h15'
B1-Cittadinanza 2h05'. The oral exam will be administered right after the written part.

CAN I TAKE BREAKS?

Breaks are incorporated in the exam schedule. Except in case of an emergency, you may not leave the room while taking each part. During the exam candidates cannot move to the next exam part before the allotted time is over.

WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

You have to bring the ID you used upon registration (valid Passport or Driving License). Each candidate should bring a black pen to complete the exam.

The use of cellphones, computers, dictionaries or notes of any kind during the written and oral part is not allowed.

HOW MANY POINTS DO I NEED TO PASS?

Level A1 and A2 have 60 points total.
(12 max / 7 min for each part).

Levels B1-C2 have 100 points total.
(20 max / 11 min for each part).

Level B1 Cittadinanza has 48 points total.
(12 max / 7 min for each part).

Candidates pass the exam if they reach the minimum points in each part. For levels A1-C2 candidates can retake, within 18 months, the part(s) they fail. This option is not available for the B1-cittadinanza. Candidates cannot register to the next exam session until they receive their result.

HOW AND WHEN WILL I RECEIVE MY EXAM RESULT?

Exam results will be posted on <https://online.unistrasi.it/riscils.asp>. You will need to insert your identification number (*Matricola*) and your date of birth DD/MM/YYYY to view the result. A summary (*Riepilogo*) will be available to print. This is the official document stating that you passed or not passed the exam or which part(s) you passed.

For the B1-Cittadinanza results will be posted 45 days after the session. For all the other levels results will be available 3 months after the session. You will be mailed your certificate within 6 months. Certificates don't have an expiration date.
