Shakespeare at Winedale is a program of the University of Texas Department of English that invites students and audiences to explore Shakespeare through performance. There are three distinct dimensions to Shakespeare at Winedale: the spring and summer classes for college students, the Outreach program, and Camp Shakespeare. The summer program is an academic course that involves the intensive study and performance of Shakespeare's plays. It is open (by application and interview) to students from all disciplines. Students in the course spend the summer at the Winedale Historical Center, working seven days a week in the converted barn that serves as our theatre. Their experience culminates with public performances in July and August. There is also a spring semester version of Shakespeare at Winedale. SHAKESPEARE AT WINEDALE OUTREACH

Shakespeare at Winedale Outreach is our Shakespeare-in-performance program for elementary schoolchildren. Every year, Outreach Coordinator Clayton Stromberger conducts workshops and residencies at several schools as well as a "Saturday Shakespeare" project at UT. Participants perform every year at the spring Winedale Festival of Play, and at the UT Children's Shakespeare Festival on campus.
