SHAKESPEARE AT WINEDALE OUTREACH

Shakespeare at Winedale Outreach brings our Shakespeare-through-performance approach into the public schools. Every school year, Outreach Coordinator Clayton Stromberger collaborates with upper-elementary classroom teachers in the Central Texas area to build year-long residency projects in which students in grades 3-5 work and play together as an ensemble and explore scenes from a variety of plays. These students then share their Shakespearean discoveries in performances at our annual Festival of Play at Winedale in April. In addition, our Outreach Players troupe is an opportunity for Outreach students to continue exploring Shakespeare at part of a team after their yearlong residency is over; these students, ages 8 through 14, meet on Saturdays on the University of Texas campus once a month and work closely with UT students from the spring and summer Winedale classes.
